We have 6 performance areas in The Caves as well as 1 at Just the Tonic at The Tron.

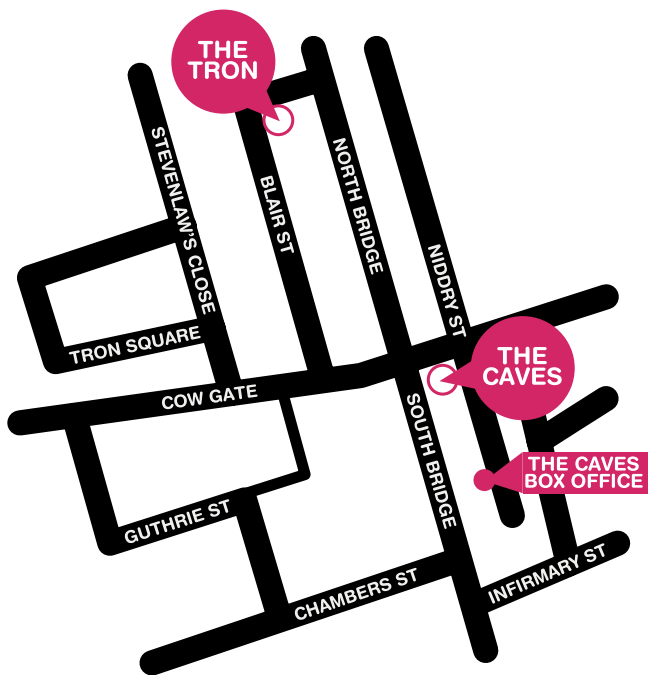

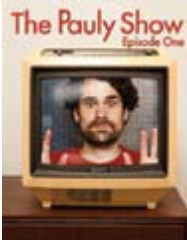

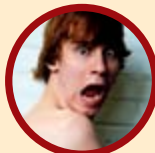
