That time of year when keen performers travel to the city of Edinburgh, their cups running over with hope, their future plans waiting for the outcome of this joyous occasion.


It is also that time of year when the culture consuming peoples of the world set their GPS destination to this great city, seeking to soak up entertainment from across our globe.
