Big Value Comedy Shows

The longest running stand up compilation show on the fringe. We ask promoter Darrell Martin to take a look at at it's fine heritage.

Starting in 1996, with a line up that included Milton Jones and Adam Bloom, the Big Value Comedy Shows have been selecting the stars of the future for almost 25 years.

Comedians such as Jim Jeffries, Sarah Millican, Jon Richardson and Romesh Ranganathan are some of those who were first exposed to the delights of Edinburgh with the Big Value Comedy Show. The show is currently produced by Darrell Martin, who runs Just the Tonic. It wasn't always that way. Many years ago Darrell was a keen performer that was desperate to be part of the show.

Pete Harris was the person who set it all up. He ran a chain of clubs called Screaming Blue Murder. According to Adam Bloom, it all came out of a conversation where Adam said to Pete that he wanted to go to Edinburgh but couldn't afford it. Within a day or 2 Pete came back to him with the concept of 'The Big Value Comedy Show'.





I have very fond memories of doing Big Value. It was a lovely way to do what can be a tough festival on a new act. I grew as a comic and made some great memories.

Big Value is the best compilation show at The Fringe. It's an excellent barometer of people who are going to go on to big things. And I'm not just saying that because I did it.

Big Value Comedy Show Early Show is at 19:30 and the Late Show is at 21:45 at Just there Tonic at The Grassmarket Centre.

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Darrell tells us: "By the time I was trying to get involved as a compere, it was already respected amongst acts, and that was only 2000. I remember it already seemed like a really established thing.

At the time I was living in Nottingham and there were not many clubs outside of London. I would travel down to London to compere at Pete's club in Kingston, in the hope of getting selected. The excitement of getting offered a place was amazing. The way the show was structured was great. Pete paid for everything, even our train tickets. All of the marketing was done by the acts (handing out flyers) and there was a profit split at the end.

The free fringe did not exist then, and there was no real way to come up to Edinburgh unless you were paying a huge load of money to the big fancy venues. To get onto Big Value meant loads to me.

The year I was on I compared the early show and in our year of doing it there was Sally

Holloway, Susan Murray, Glenn Wool, Greg Burns, Marty Wilson, Johnny Candon and a certain Micky Flanaghan.

In 2001 I received a call asking if I wanted to put a show in the Café Royal because Pete was jacking it all in. I was a promoter as well as a performer. So, I called Pete and asked him if I could use the name. He generously agreed. I kept the whole format the same, except I made a conscious effort to make the selecting less Londoncentric.

In the years that followed the whole festival has changed. The Café Royal shut down (it had been taken over and very badly run... long story). The Big Value carried on each year. It has been in Underbelly, in a tent at the back of C Venue Adams Building. (There is now an IBIS Hotel on the site), and in The Big Cave. It is now in The Grassmarket Centre.

Over the years we have auditioned hundreds of people, and taken a lot of comedians up to the festival. Some of them become regular acts on the circuit. Some go on to become big stars. Some go off and do other things. But each year we try and bring varied and interesting shows.

General Status is boot camp for young comics. I had a great time, played to amazing audiences and learned how to become a better comic. We have included a list of some of the acts we have had up until 2012 that have gone on to become known outside of the circuit. There are others, but the list would have been too big. We didn't bother with after 2012 because you probably wouldn't have heard of them (yet), but it would include the likes of Adam Rowe and Kiri Pritchard McLean. You probably wouldn't have heard of Micky Flanmaghan in 2007 or Romesh Ranganathan until 2 years ago! (unless you'd been to Big Value Comedy Show)

Come and see who we have this year. They are always great shows. You get a 2 hour show (including 2 drinks breaks) and it is a variety night. We love it... we hope you do too!
